A MESSAGE FROM MRS. AMBADY - ON THE OCCASION OF INSTITUTION OF DR. B. M. AMBADY ORATION - AT THE 4TH ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF I. A. D. V. & L - held at New Delhi, 1976.

Friends,

The organizers of this Conference have requested me to say a few words to you. I came to Delhi to conduct the marriage of my daughter and remained in New Delhi to avail of the last opportunity I will have to meet and say good-bye to all our friends at this I. A. D. V. & L. Conference. You will all remember the Conference which was held last year at Trivandrum when my husband was the President.
