MEMBERSHIP EXAMINATION

The Indian Academy of Medical Sciences has been conducting postgraduate Examinations in different disciplines of medical sciences on an All India basis with a view to admit candidates to the *Membership of the Academy*. This examination is of a very high standard with special emphasis on scholarly attainments in research, teaching experience or clinical works of high quality. Thus the Membership of the academy is considered the hallmark of proficiency and experience.

Membership examination is held in the following subjects :—

1. Medicine
2. Surgery
3. Obstetrics & Gynecology.
4. Anatomy
5. Physiology
6. Pharmacology
7. Pathology
8. Ophthalmology
9. Paediatrics
10. Orthopaedics
11. Preventive & Social Medicine.

A registered medical graduate of an Indian University, or equivalent qualification included in the First Schedule of the Indian Medical Council Act is eligible. He/She must have undergone a recognised course of training for not less than two years for Part-I and four years for Part-II (including one year's housemanship* or its equivalent).

The examinations are held twice a year in January and July at New Delhi. The next examination will be held in July 1971.
