Errata: Review article: Hidradenitis suppurativa: A systematic review and meta-analysis of therapeutic interventions

Sir,

The above interesting article in Indian J Dermatol Venereol Leprol 2019; 85, 248-57 has a printer's devil among the enlisted associated conditions – the letter “S” of the SAPHO syndrome representing synovitis, not sinusitis.¹

The textbook mentions pustulosis, rather than specifically palmoplantar pustulosis, though the latter occurs predominantly;² many other associated pustular disorders³ such as pustular psoriasis, pyoderma gangrenosum, and linear IgA bullous dermatosis too can occur.
