## WHAT IS YOUR DIAGNOSIS?



50 year old male, having a rapidly growing, raised, ulcerated tumor near inner canthus of right eye. It has a collar like base. There is an indurated scar on right cheek, fixed to the underlying bone.

## Differential Diagnosis:

- 1. Squamous Cell Carcinoma
- 2. Keratoacanthoma
- 3. Basal Cell Carcinoma

## History:

Patient was treated with X-radiation for Carcinoma of right cheek 6 months prior to the onset of this tumor. Biopsy shows in situ carcinoma of the epidermis with Collarette appearance of the periphery of the tumor.

Keratoacanthoma is a proliferative in situ carcinoma of the epidermis. It spreads locally rapidly. Local excision and electrocoagulation give the best results.

Treatment:

Final Diagnosis: Keratoacanthoma
