

**SEPTRIN DONATION****FOR BANGLA DESH REFUGEE RELIEF**

500,000 tablets of SEPTRIN - a new antibacterial drug - have been donated by Burroughs Wellcome & Co. (India) Private Ltd., Bombay, to the Rehabilitation and Relief Department of the Government of India for use in the present cholera epidemic amongst Bangla Desh Refugees.
