- a) A case of generalized eczema was demonstrated. His blood uric acid was higher than normal. It was observed that patient responded to saliscate therapy. The purpose of demonstration was to explore new avenues e.g. metabolic anomolies etc. as etiological agents in the causation of eczemas.
- (b) Dr. S. C. Desai gave an illustrative talk on his recent tour abroad when he attended the first International Conference under the aegis of International Society of Tropical Dermatology. He was elected Vice-President. He emphasized the immense value of such knowledge with pleasure tours both as regards scientific exchange of views and personal contacts with our counterparts in other countries.
