- Publishing articles of highest standard, with insistence on ethical clearance for original articles and/or conflicts of interests from the contributors if any
- Obtaining and organizing editorial team review before peer reviews and appointing reviewers
- Corresponding with authors and organizing adjudication wherever needed
- To publish the journal in time and to supervise and work closely with team members to meet publication deadlines and improve overall efficiency
- To maintain and update the IJDVL website
- To submit audited accounts of the journal at the annual general body meeting of IADVL
- All other duties as assigned in the Constitution of IADVL

The selection of the new Editor would be made before the DERMACON INTERNATIONAL2019 conference in January 2019 for approval by the Central Council and the General body of the IADVL. The Editor would be appointed for an initial 3-year term. The new Editor is required to join the present team during the transition period in order to acquaint himself/herself with the day-to-day functioning of the journal, and is expected to be fully functional from opening AGBM during DERMACON 2020.
