INSTRUCTIONS TO CONTRIBUTORS

- ❑ Manuscripts will not be processed until they are submitted in proper form. Address the manuscript to Dr. R. Mathai, Managing Editor, IJDV & L., CMC Hospital, Vellore-632004 (India). Manuscripts are received with the understanding that they are not under simultaneous consideration by any other publication.
- ❑ Send a declaration that the article sent for publication has not been published so far and the same will not be sent for publication in any other Journal.
- ❑ Submit manuscript in duplicate double-spaced typewritten using 9" x 11" paper.
Use separate sheet for title page, summary, legends for illustrations and references.
- ❑ Summary should not exceed 200 words.
- ❑ Titles should be short, specific and clear. Omit phrases such as "The use of", "Observations on", etc.
- ❑ If the manuscript was presented at a meeting this should be stated on the title page and authors' full addresses.
- ❑ Charts and Graphs be drawn neatly on white cardboard by Indian ink. Remember that all details must be clearly legible when reduced to the size used in this journal.
- ❑ Tables should be typed on separate sheets with due reference to the text. Submit photographs as individual glossy prints in duplicate, untrimmed and unmounted, not larger than 2½" and 5" in width for half page size and full page size of the Journal respectively. Number each with pencil lightly on the back and indicate top.
- ❑ References: They should be typewritten, double-spaced, beginning on a new sheet of paper headed "References". Number them in the text in the order of citation and prepare the bibliography in the same order (**not alphabetically**). The style of the references must conform to the examples given below.

Examples :

Article

(Last name of the author followed by initials without internal punctuation, except for commas separating two or more authors (in the case of multiple authorship, only the first three names should be listed): Title of paper. Abbreviated Journal name using INDEX MEDICUS form, Volume number, initial page number, Year.)

Sundaramurthy M, Prasad KN, Sathyanarayanan AM, et al : Case report of a rare type of apocrine gland, tumour of groin, Indian J Dermatol Venereol, 38 : 197, 1972.

Book

(Author's name: Title of the book, publisher, city of publication, year. Yawalkar SJ : Leprosy for Practitioners, Popular Prakashan, Bombay, 1967.)

Chapter in Edited Book

(Author's name: Title of the chapter, title of the book, Edition (if any), Editor's name, Publisher, city of publication, year and initial page number of the chapter).
