Shivakumar, a paper on therapy of psoriasis with psorlens by Dr. T. V. Venkatesan from Madurai and a paper on Parthenium Dermatitis (Phyto-dermatitis) by Dr. K. M. Prakash from Bangalore were organised. Dr. (Mrs.) Z. Isaac as Chairman and Dr. M. K. Rama Rao, Professor of Dermato-Venereology, Bangalore Medical College, as co-chairman conducted these sessions. Dr. K. Siddappa, Secretary of the Branch of the Association was also in the chair during these sessions.
