MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING HELD IN FEBRUARY 1965

The Annual Meeting of the Northern Association of Dermatologists and Venereologists was spread over two days, viz.

Scientific session and General Body Meeting - 20-2-1965

Social get together, Picnic and Picture -21-2-1965.

The meeting on the 20th February was held in the Main Lecture Threatre of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences at 3 P. M. Twenty-nine members attended. As the members assembled in the Hall, the Presdient, Prof. Kandhari welcomed them all and admired their enthusiasm and cooperation in the efficient running of this branch. He exhorted them to contribute substantially in the scientific deliberations of the association so as to raise the standard of this speciality. He reported briefly the proceedings of the Annual Conference of the Indian Association of Dermatologists and Venereologists held at Bangalore, of which he was the Hony. General Secretary. The conference which was largely attended proved a grand success and there was a high standard of scientific papers and Symposia. Apart from 41 delegates, the Conference was widely attended by members from other specialities. Prof. Stuttgen from Dussoldorf, West Germany attended the Conference. He announced amidst cheers that Dr. Harbhajan Singh was unanimously elected as President, Dr. K. C. Kandhari as Vice-President and Dr. D. N. Mullay as the Hony. Secretary of the All India Body.

The Secretory Dr. D. N. Mullay then presented the Annual Report of the year 1964. Eleven monthly clinical meettings were held during the year by rotation in the various Hospitals of the Town as detailed below:-

The total number of clinical cases presented during these meetings was 54. The Executive Committee met 5 times during the year to discuss various problems. He referred to the conferences of Post-graduate medical education held in November 1964 and February 1965 at Delhi under the aegis of Medical Council of India and the Association of Post-graduate Medical Education respectively. He further emphasized that the delegates from our branch played major role in the sectional seminars and the recommendations put forth by them

received widespread support from the eminent educationists from all over the country. He congratulated Dr. Ratan Singh and Dr. L. K. Bhutani for having been appointed as Assistant Professor and Lecturer in the All India Institute of Medical Sciences. Finally he thanked the President Dr. Kandhari for his guidance and help during the tenure of his office.

The Treasurer Dr. B. M. S. Bedi, then read out the statement of Accounts and apprised the members regarding the financial position of the Association.
