The guest lectures were given by Prof. J. Sharan, Retd. Prof. of Pathology and Dr. (Miss) Margaret Owen, Leprologist on tumours of skin and Recent advances in the treatment of leprosy respectively. This was followed by a panel discussion on treatment of leprosy which was chaired by Prof. B. N. Prasad. In the panel discussion Prof. B. N. Prasad discussed the role of intraneural injection of hydrocortisone in the treatment of neuritis in leprosy. Dr. Kedar Pd. Singh opined that oral corticosteroids be preferred in the treatment of neuritis in leprosy. Dr. Margaret Owen discussed the recent advances in the treatment of leprosy. Dr. A. K. Singh discussed the difficulty in pin pointing indeterminate type of leprosy and the treatment of indeterminate leprosy. Dr. A. S. Prasad discussed the diagnosis of early leprosy and the role of sweat test as a tool of diagnosis of leprosy in suspected macular Hansen's natch.

The afternoon session was scheduled for a panel discussion on laboratory investigations and treatment of syphilis. It was chaired by Dr. Kedar Prasad Singh.

- Dr. R. P. Upadhyaya discussed the problem of biological false positive reactions in cases suspected of syphilis.
 - Dr. Mathura Prasad gave a lecture on early syphilis.
- Dr. Ganga Prasad spoke on laboratory diagnosis of syphilis and its significance.
- Dr. (Miss) P. Prasad discussed the management of early syphilis.
- Dr. L. N. Sinha and Dr. R. K. Dutta took active part in the discussion. Dr. R. K. Dutta also elucidated the pharmacological aspects of the drugs used in leprosy and syphilis.

The conference was then declared closed. The delegates met later in the night to listen to Sri K. Prasad, an eminent lawyer talk on sex-crimes and society.
