


WHAT IS YOUR DIAGNOSIS?

A 12 year old male patient presented with scaly patches on the body noticed since infancy. He was born to consanguineous parents and one of 4 siblings. There was no family history of similar problem. Lesions were mainly asymptomatic.

Examination showed multiple areas of scaling with roughly polycyclic borders in the axillae, neck and scapular regions. Lesions were rather symmetrically distributed. Differential diagnosis :

1. Flexural psoriasis
 2. Ichthyosis linearis circumflexa
 3. Lamellar ichthyosis.

The early onset of the disease with a negative family history suggested a recessively inherited dermatoses. The peculiar poly-cyclic borders which were raised and scaly were consistent with a diagnosis of ichthyosis linearis circumflexa. No hair abnormalities were detected and no eye lesions.

Final diagnosis : Ichthyosis linearis circumflexa
