MEDICAL EDUCATION FOUNDATION

The Indian Association for the Advancement of Medical Education at its 9th annual session in January 1970 has approved the establishment of the Medical Education Foundation with a view to collect funds and to utilise the interests accrued from the same for the following purposes:—

- a) to further the cause of Medical Fducation in India;
- b) To offer fellowships to medical graduates for higher medical studies;
- c) to offer grants for student research including research in Community Health in rural areas, travel grants to teachers, exchange of teachers, exchange of students etc.
- d) to undertake evalution of education programmes of Medical, Paramedical, Dental, Nursing and Public Health personnel;
- e) to prepare, print and publish any paper or periodicals and monograph of books in furtherance of the objects of the Society and to contribute to any such periodicals etc.
- f) to do and perform all other acts, matters and things they may assist in conduce to or be necessary for the fulfilment of the above mentioned aims and objects of the society.

The Memorandum of the Association of the Medical Education Foundation was published in the Journal of Medical Education December, 1969 Volume VIII No. 9.
