3. Resolved to request the Government of Andhra Pradesh for creation of Civil Surgeon posts in Government Headquarters Hospital in all districts of Andhra Pradesh and also to create Additional Professors posts in Dermatology and Venereology Departments in all the Medical Colleges, for better patient care.

All the participants, warned on the danger of developing mycobacterial resistance, by PULSE therapy in leprosy and concluded that it should not be followed in our patients. Dr. George in his remarks stated that more importance for us is to detect and treat more number of cases rather than worrying about dapsone resistance which is "not yet a problem in Kerala". Dr. Jacob Thomas, proposed the vote of thanks which was followed by dinner and fellowship.
