CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT FOR THE MAKING OF A COMMUNICATION AT THE XIIIth INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF DERMATOLOGY

MUNICH - 31st July - 5th August 1967

Communications shall deal with one of the Themes or Symposia included in the Congress programme.

Requests for such enrollment must be sent, in quadruplicate, to the Organizer of the Theme or Symposium concerned.

BEFORE 15th NOVEMBER 1966.

They shall include:

- 1. The Presenter's name and those of his collaborators;
- 2. The title of the communication in the language in which it will be given and published (French, English, German, Spanish);
- 3. A resume of same in English (with translation of the title) containing not more than 100 words;
- 4. The Presenter's adress.

The same congressist may not make more than one oral exposition. His name may appear, however, a second time on the programme, (I report and I communication or 2 communications) provided that, on one of the two occasions, it will be associated with those of collaborators and does not come first.
